RACE RULES

- The event is held under the auspices and rules of World Athletics (WA), Athletics South Africa (ASA), Central Gauteng Athletics (CGA).
- Athletes indemnify and will not hold responsible the national, provincial and regional athletics bodies, sponsors and the race organisers against all claims or actions of whatever nature arising from participation in the event.
- Athletes participate entirely at their own risk. By entering the event athletes confirm that they are medically fit to participate and accept full responsibility for their health. Participants must provide the name and contact number of their next of kin when entering the race.
- Licensed athletes must wear their permanent license numbers in the front and back of their registered club vest or T-shirt. The issued race number must be worn on the front without obscuring sponsors name/s or logo/s.
- Athletes not affiliated with a club must purchase a temporary license when entering online or at the registration venue before the start of the race and these must be worn at the back of the upper garment and the issued race number on the front of the upper garment.
- Foreign athletes must purchase a temporary license unless as provided for in rule 22.
- Athletes competing for age category prizes must wear clearly visible age category tags of the appropriate size on the front and back of their registered club vest or T-shirt. Failure to wear age category tags will result in athlete forfeiting prize money.
- When an athlete cannot be present at the prize giving ceremony, by prior arrangement, a representative of the prize-winning athlete may collect the award on the athlete's behalf during the award ceremony. Failing the above, the athlete will forfeit his/her prize money. Prize winners must present a valid identity document to the appointed referees before prize-giving or at any other time required.
- Walkers competing for walkers' prizes must wear walker tags on the front and back of their running tops and must comply with the ASA Domestic Rules and Regulations.
- The race organiser reserves the right to withhold prizes until all necessary winner details are verified and all post-race mandatory requirements, including anti-doping procedures, have been completed.
- Disputes, appeals, or any race-related incidents must be lodged in writing with the appointed Chief Referee within 30 minutes of the incident. Appeals must be accompanied by a refundable administration fee of R500.00, which will be returned if the appeal is upheld.

- No athlete shall be denied prize money solely for starting without an electronic timing chip, if referees have positively identified the athlete at all checkpoints.
- The use of earphones, headsets, or similar devices during the race is prohibited. Athletes who transgress may be disqualified.
- No blades, cyclist or mechanically operated devices allowed in the race.
- No 2-, 3-or 4-wheel carts, prams (mechanically or manually operated), or wheelchairs are permitted without special permission has been granted from the race organiser. All such participants MUST start at the back of the field.
- No animals or pets are permitted to participate.
- All instructions issued by traffic officers and race officials must be always obeyed.
- Athletes may not run with another athlete's race number unless a formal substitution has been completed and approved by the race organiser.
- The race organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or remove any persons under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol, or any person deemed disorderly, or engaging in inappropriate behaviour, vandalism or conduct bringing the sport into disrepute, including evading payment of race entry fees.
- Athletes who participate in a race without securing a valid race entry will be disqualified, will forfeit all associated benefits, and may face disciplinary action.
- Littering before, during, or after the race, including in the vicinity of the venue, is prohibited. Athletes must dispose of litter in designated bins. Sufficient waste bins will be placed at every water point and on race route. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action.
- A Foreign Athlete Licence entitles the athlete to be a member of a local club, wear the colours of that club, enter competitions as a local athlete, and win prizes in an individual capacity. A foreign athlete may NOT however form part of a club team until they meet the eligibility requirements to represent a member federation as outlined in WA Rule 4.3 and 5.
- Entry fees are non-refundable including if the event is cancelled for reasons beyond the control of the organiser.
- Failure to comply with these rules, or any other rules issued by the race organiser, may result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of prize money, nullification of results, or a combination thereof. Further remedial action may be taken in line with the CGA/ASA Constitution. The decision of the race referee is final.
- These rules must be read together with the ASA Domestic Rules and Regulations, and the CGA Rules and Regulations Manual for more information.
