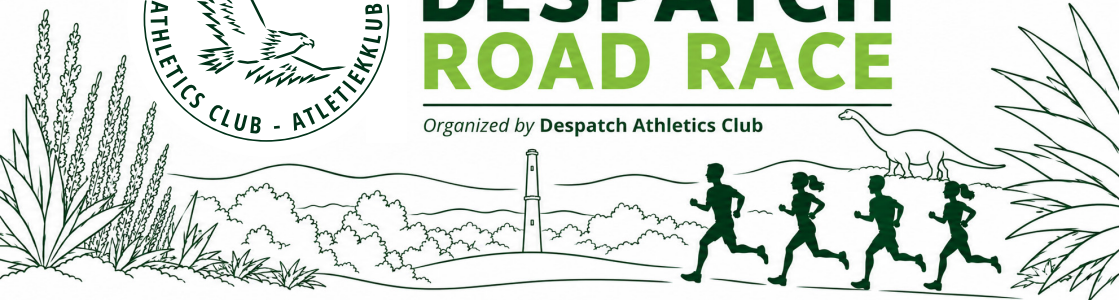

RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

- Breach of any regulation or requirement may lead to instant removal or disqualification without appeal. The race organiser and safety officer have the final decision in this regard. It is every athlete's responsibility to read and comply with these requirements.
- Athletes must run in official club colours with 2026 licence numbers on the front and back of the vest and official race number on the front of the vest.
- Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary license to be worn on the back of vest or plain coloured T-shirt, with the official race number on the front of the vest / T-shirt.
- Temporally licensed athletes are not covered by ASA group insurance and are encouraged to join an athletics clubs.
- Race numbers will contain a chip and must be clearly visible at the finish line.
DO NOT bend the envelope.
- Age category tags must be worn on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify for category prizes.
- Prize winners may be requested to provide proof of age.
- Wearing of earphones are not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
- No prams / dogs are allowed on the 10 KM route.
- The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- The Prize Giving will commence at 08h45. Prize Winners to be on their club colours (tracksuits / running apparel) and may be requested to provide proof of age.
- Entries may be handed in at Brian Bands, SuperSpar Despatch, Klinikare Despatch, or UD Sport in Uitenhage.
- The closing date for pre-entries will be Wednesday, 26 August 2026, at 12h00.
- Full results will also be posted on www.epathletics.co.za.
- No Alcohol may be brought onto the premises.
- Collection of race numbers (pre-entries) will be available at the Despatch SuperSpar on Friday, 28 August 2026, between 18h00 and 19h30. Late entries will also be available.
- Collection of numbers and late entries will be available at the race venue from 05h30 until 6h30 on the morning of the race.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- The no seconding rule will apply. No private vehicles will be allowed on the route to second athletes.
- There will be three refreshment stations on the 10 KM route and one refreshment station on the 5 KM route. Please support the Anti-littering campaign. Refuse bins will be provided along the route.
- Please discard used water sachets into or near to these bins. Littering is an offence and may lead to disqualification.
- A receipt slip may be required in the case of any discrepancy with pre-entries.
- Organised in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA.
